The Hiding Place Summer Reading Assignment

Choose one of the prompts below and compose a one-page response using 3 pieces of textual evidence to support your claim. Make sure to answer every part of the prompt in full to receive full credit. Use specific textual examples from the book to strengthen your response. All responses should be original and authentically yours (no Wikipedia, Google, SparkNotes, etc.)

In-text citations should look like this: (Ten Boom pg. #)

Example: (Ten Boom 17).

Prompt #1: Discuss the necessity of perseverance for physical and spiritual survival in the novel. Consider the following:
-How does Corrie keep her faith alive after her arrest? -What is most needed to survive amidst the infamies of war? -How does Corrie's belief in God shape her feelings of moral responsibility during the war?

Prompt #2: The German Lieutenant Rahms, who interrogates Corrie for several days while she is in Scheveningen federal penitentiary, tells Corrie, "I am in a prison...a prison stronger than this one." Explain what Lieutenant Rahms means and explain how they both suffer in such different circumstances (physically, mentally, emotionally, spiritually, etc.)

Prompt #3: Point out 3 instances of irony in the novel and explain what makes them ironic. Use specific textual support to make your claim.

Prompt #4: Using any of the brainstorming activities that we worked on together as a class, compose a response about how Corrie Ten Boom demonstrates how the Ten Booms are encouraged and driven by God's love throughout the novel.
